The Academic & Talent Programme for Grade 6 is our latest scholarship programme that was first introduced in the 2018–19 school year. This programme is established to provide opportunity to young learners to get familiarised and adapt well with the international curriculum through extra academic lessons in Maths and English. The programme also aims to serve those who are passionate about developing one of the talent tracks in Sports, Art and Music as a life-long talent, by nurturing and empowering the student's talent through financial support and programme's commitments. Putting together both academic and extra-curricular benefits, this programme creates a balanced path and workload for potential students, while reinforcing our recognition and promotion of a diverse learning community.

The Scholarship value is UP TO 50% for the entity of the Cambridge Secondary 1 Programme.

CURRICULUM OVERVIEW: CAMBRIDGE SECONDARY 1

The Cambridge Secondary 1 develops skills and understanding in English, Mathematics and Science for the first three years of secondary education (Grade 6–8). It combines a world-class curriculum, high-quality support for teachers and integrated assessment.

10 compulsory subjects: English, Maths, Humanities, French/Vietnamese, Information Communication Technology (ICT), Science, Art, Music, Drama, Physical Education (PE)

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Students of age for Grade 6 of the 2020–2021 academic year.
- Students with good English level and/or high academic achievements.
- Students with commitment to attend a specialist Talent related to music, art or sport.

ENTRANCE ASSESSMENT

- One (01) 60-min written test in English
- One (01) 40-min written test in Mathematics
- One (01) interview with the Headmaster or Head of Secondary of ISV.

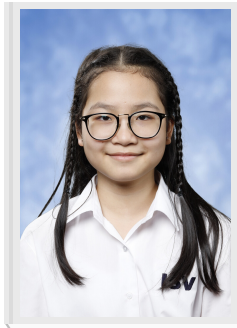

ENRICHMENT CLASSES FOR ACADEMIC & TALENT STUDENTS

With the aim to continue to develop our scholars' academic studies, and be part of the opportunity to shape ISV's future scholars in higher grade levels, after-school enrichment classes have been provided to our Academic & Talent students throughout the three-year Cambridge Secondary 1 programme. The classes focus on English & Global Perspectives, being developed and taught by ISV highly experienced Secondary teachers. Apart from English, the Cambridge IGCSE Global Perspectives is a groundbreaking and stimulating course that stretches across traditional subject boundaries and develops transferable skills. It is both cross-curricular and skills-based and taps into the way learners of today enjoy learning, including team work, presentations, projects, and working with other learners around the world. The emphasis is on developing the ability to think critically about a range of global issues where there is always more than one point of view. The classes, along with our rigorous academic programme, help our internal students to prepare well for the Cambridge IGCSE in Grade 9, and have a bigger chance to gain valued scholarships in Grade 9 & Grade 11, which cover up to 100% tuition fee.
